ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the program will be selective. To apply students must fulfil the criteria given below:

- 1. A three-year Bachelor Degree with a Master's degree or a Four-year Bachelor Degree in any discipline
- 2. At least Second Class in all exams or a minimum CGPA of 2.5 on a 4-point scale
- At least one years of work experience after Graduation.
- Candidates with a two-year Bachelor degree will require eight years of job experience to be eligible for admission
- Candidates will not require a written test but must pass an oral test for admission





SEMESTER

The program is offered in 3 regular semesters in a year - Autumn, Spring, and Summer. Admission also takes place thrice a year.

DURATION/TIME LIMITATION

Students can finish the program within 3 semesters because of waivers or transfer course/(s). However, students will be allowed up to 5 years from the date of initial enrollment to complete their degree requirements.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Students must complete a minimum of 33 credit hours at IUB EMBA Program to obtain the EMBA degree.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

To graduate, students must earn credit for 16 courses (48 credit hours) with a minimum CGPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale and meet the residency requirement of IUB EMBA Program.



PROBATION

Students will be required to maintain a minimum CGPA of 2.5 throughout the academic period or else they will be put on provisional status. If students fail to raise their CGPA 2.5 or above within the next two semesters, they will not be allowed to continue the course and be dismissed from the program.

COURSE WAIVER & TRANSFER CREDITS

Students eligible for Waiver and/or Transfer may apply to the Graduate Program Office. However, waiver will be allowed only for foundation courses of the EMBA Program to a maximum of 15 credit hours (5 courses) and Transfer (maximum 6 credits & requires latest CGPA 2.50) may be allowed for courses subject to the following:

- The courses taken elsewhere were of undergraduate level (waiver) or graduate level (transfer)
- The grades earned in those courses were at least 'B / B- or equivalent
- The Dean's Office/equivalence committee, which may or may not ask the applicant to take a written or oral test, considers the application for waiver satisfactory.

All applications for waiver and transfer must be submitted to the Graduate Program Office within 3 days of admission along with a non-refundable processing fee of Tk. 150 for each credit applied for. Waiver and transfer credits will not be counted to calculate CGPA.
